


EuroDIG is build on an open network to discuss and exchange on emerging issues and challenges concerning the Internet, between all stakeholders (governments, international organisations, business and civil society) and other interested communities, covering the 47 member states of the Council of Europe.

EuroDIG is inspired by and inspiring the global UN Internet Governance Forum (IGF) and the other regional and national IGF initiatives. EuroDIG was launched in 2008 and, so far, has held seven annual events (Strasbourg 2008, Geneva 2009, Madrid 2010, Belgrade 2011, Stockholm 2012, Lisbon 2013, Berlin 2014).
